

JOHNSON COUNTY SKYWARN NET JULY 11, 2020

SUMMARY

The Johnson County Skywarn Net was called at 1725 (L) on July 11, 2020 in response to a severe thunderstorm warning issued by NWS that included parts of Johnson County. There were multiple reports of hail that reached one inch diameter, and wind gusts were estimated or measured at about 50 mph. These reports were forwarded to NWS Davenport by landline. At least one additional severe thunderstorm warning was issued for the county as other cells moved in. The net stood down at 1912 (L) after the last warning box cleared the county.

SIGNIFICANT TIMES AND EVENTS (ALL TIMES LOCAL)

1803 pea-size hail began in North Liberty

1805 one-half inch hail began in North Liberty

1808 estimated 8/10 inch hail, North Liberty, with wind gusts about 50 mph

1820 hail, some approaching one inch reported in Tiffin

1830 hail, about quarter size reported in west Iowa City

1833 hail, ranging from 1/2 inch to 3/4 inch reported in and south of Iowa City

1833 hail, ranging from pea size to one inch reported in east Iowa City

1836 hail, about one inch reported in east Iowa City, along with street flooding

1838 hail, about quarter size and 47 mph wind reported as the storm passed east of Iowa City
